Nineteen international dental experts to lecture in Rome

At the 4th International Expert Symposium to be held by Ivoclar Vivadent in June 2018, digital and esthetic dentistry will be in the spotlight.

For the fourth time in a row, Ivoclar Vivadent will be hosting an International Expert Symposium (IES) for dentists and laboratory technicians. New: concurrent breakout sessions

In addition to the plenary lectures, various breakout sessions on exciting topics will be simultaneously offered for the first time. They can either be booked online or directly at the event. Participants who register for the Symposium before 19 March 2018 will receive an early-bird discount. The languages of the Symposium will be Italian and English. All lectures will be simultaneously translated into German, English, French, Italian, Spanish and Russian. The 4th International Expert Symposium will be held at the Auditorium Parco della Musica, which is located in the very heart of Rome.
